

## **Check and Connect Intervention Script:** **Chisago Lakes High School**

### **Morning Check-In Script:**

The student will meet with the Check and Connect Coordinator each morning when arriving to school before first hour. During this “Check-In” the student and coordinator engage in the following activities:

- Student enters name in a raffle for showing up (reward given at end of week from this drawing)
- Check in with student to ensure they have the needed supplies for the day. Any items the student may need are provided.
- Check in with student to see what his/her mind-set and outlook for the day is. Send student off to class with positives.
- Once per month, coordinator will have student complete Student Engagement probe during morning check-in.

### **Problem Solving Lunch Session Script**

The Check and Connect coordinator and individual student will meet weekly or bi-weekly to discuss current issues regarding behaviors and/or academics. The coordinator will work with student on problem solving techniques as they relate to these issues. The goal is to educate the student on how to work through issues using a problem solving process on their own. Once per month, the coordinator will have the student complete a Student Engagement probe during their lunch session and discuss areas of concern.

### **Progress Monitoring/Data Collection Script**

The Check and Connect coordinator will monitor the student’s behavior and academic progress from the previous week using Check and Connect Monitoring Sheet. This task is will be done on the Monday following the previous week and is used to plan the student/coordinator lunch meeting. The Check and Connect Monitoring Sheet is a form filled out by the coordinator that includes academic and behavioral data.

In addition to the Check and Connect Monitoring Sheet, the coordinator will track the data from the student engagement probes using the Excel file set up by school psychologist. The goal is to see an increase in the student’s engagement in school as measured by the probe.

Once per month, the Check and Connect Monitoring Sheets and the Student Engagement probe data will be reviewed by the problem solving team.

### **Reward system**

- Weekly drawing from raffle
- Unstructured rewards will be given randomly, such as Golden Behavior Tickets
- Lunch will be provided for student when meeting with coordinator
- Larger rewards for progressing toward and/or attaining term end goals as set by student and coordinator will be available using a point system
