Dr. George Sugai is a professor at the University of Connecticut. Dr. Sugai is widely known for his research emphasizing effective applications of applied behavior analysis principles and PBS procedures to problems found in educational contexts. He is a popular presenter at local, national, and international conferences. Dr. Sugai and colleagues have established the Center for Behavioral Education and Research in the Neag School of Education to improve academic and social behavior outcomes for students. He has published over 100 articles, numerous monographs, and two college textbooks on effective teaching practices and applied behavior analysis. Dr. Sugai is currently co-director of the National Center on Positive Behavior Interventions and Supports.
