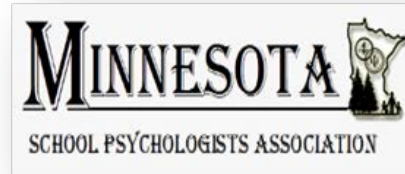

What is Day at the Hill?

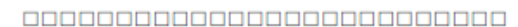
